

BOWL SHOW 2011

the rules for the 2011 Bowl Show to be held at each monthly meeting are as follows:

- 1. All bowls should be checked in no later than 7:00 p.m.*
- 2. Three entries in each class per member maximum.*
- 3. Any transparent flat-sided container will be allowed.*
- 4. One fish per entry, except in special classes.*
- 5. No gravel or plants may be used in fish entries.*
- 6. A member may have any other member bring their entries to the Bowl Show two (2) times during the year if they can't attend.*
- 7. The following point system will be used:
1st place = 10 points
2nd place = 7 points
3rd place = 4 points
Each entry that does not place will be awarded one point.*
- 8. Entries will be judged as follows:*

<i>Health, condition, department</i>	<i>35 points</i>
<i>Fins</i>	<i>30 points</i>
<i>Size relative to full grown</i>	<i>20 points</i>
<i>Color</i>	<i><u>15</u> points</i>
<i>Total possible for each entry</i>	<i>100 points</i>

(except for plants that will be sight judged, fry in March will be relative to their age for the species, and bonus points in June.)
- 9. The following prizes will be awarded at the end of the Bowl Show year:
Highest total points = \$30.00 cash
2nd highest total points = \$20.00 cash
3rd highest total points = \$10.00 cash*
- 10. The reverse side lists the entries to be shown each month in 2011.*

JANUARY: CLASS A - DANIOS, RASBORAS AND BARBS
CLASS B - GUPPY (MALE OR FEMALE)

FEBRUARY: CLASS A - ANY EGGLAYER PAIR
CLASS B - ANY LIVEBEARER PAIR, EXCLUDING GUPPY
(A pair is a male and female of the same species. The pair may be shown in separate containers.)

MARCH: CLASS A – CORYDORAS-TYPE CATFISH
CLASS B - CATFISH OTHER THAN CORYDORAS TYPE

APRIL: CLASS A - OPEN, ANY EGGLAYER
CLASS B - OPEN, ANY LIVEBEARER

MAY: CLASS A - 6 EGGLAYER FRY
CLASS B - 6 LIVEBEARER FRY
(Must be from your own spawning and between 60-120 days old. First date of spawning is January 13 and last date of spawning is March 22.)

JUNE: CLASS A - UNCOMMON EGGLAYER
CLASS B - UNCOMMON LIVEBEARER
(0 to 10 points to be awarded for how uncommon the judges consider the entry.)

JULY: CLASS A - RAINBOWS AND BLUE EYES
CLASS B - LOACHES, BOTIAS AND SHARKS

AUGUST: CLASS A - ANABANTIDS
CLASS B - OPEN, ANY LIVEBEARER

SEPTEMBER: CLASS A - PLATIES AND SWORDS
CLASS B - AQUARIUM PLANTS
(Plants will be shown in clear plastic bags, potted or bare root and with or without water.)

OCTOBER: CLASS A - NEW WORLD CICHLID
CLASS B - OLD WORLD CICHLID

NOVEMBER: CLASS A - TETRAS
CLASS B - ANY LIVEBEARER COMMONLY CALLED A "MOLLY"

DECEMBER: CLASS A - ANY EGGLAYER
CLASS B - ANY LIVEBEARER
